

March 29 – April 4, 2010

Sunday, April 4, 9:30 AM. Moderate rain early this evening, ending by midnight, 0.25 to 1 inches possible, low flooding risk. Mostly cloudy & cool with scattered showers tomorrow. Next chance of rain (showers) forecast at the end on next week (Friday).

Saturday, April 3, 9:30 AM. Partly cloudy through tonight. Increasing clouds Sunday morning. Windy with rain Sunday afternoon and evening, .25 to .75 inches, low flooding risk. Showers Monday. Dry the rest of the week.

Friday, April 2, 8:30 AM. Rain likely up to 0.40 inches for today. For Saturday very small chance of very small amounts of rain. A larger storm is forecasted for Sunday with rain up to 3/4 inch. For Monday and Tuesday there is a chance of very small amounts of rain. No rain forecasted for Wednesday. Low flooding risk for today.

Thursday, April 1, 9:00 AM. No rain forecasted for today. For Friday, rain up to 0.35 inches. For Saturday very small chance of very small amounts of rain. A larger storm is forecasted for Sunday with rain up to 1/2 inch. For Monday and Tuesday there is a chance for very small amounts of rain. Low flooding risk for today.

Wednesday, March 31, 8:30 AM. Rain likely tonight up to 1/4 inch. No rain is forecast for Thursday. For Friday rain likely up to 1/4 inch. For Saturday, very small chance of very small amounts of rain. Sunday is forecast to be the largest storm of the week with rain likely up to 1/2 inch. For Monday, a very small amount of rain is likely. Low flooding risk.

Tuesday, March 30, 8:45 AM. Rain up to 1/4 inch for today. For Wednesday, rain up to 1/2 inch. For Thursday through Saturday chance of very small amounts of rain. For Sunday, rain likely up to 3/4 inch.

Monday, March 29, 10:15 AM. Chance of very small amounts of rain for today. For Tuesday, rain up to 1/4 inch. Very small amounts of rain likely Wednesday. Chance of very small amounts of rain Thursday through Saturday. Rain likely Sunday up to 1/2 inch. Low flooding risk.
