INTRODUCTION:

The Solano County Water Agency is recruiting for 15 Lake Berryessa Mussel Prevention internship positions. The job duties are described below.

- Lake Berryessa Mussel Prevention Intern- 15 Openings

Lake Berryessa Mussel Prevention Internship

This is a temporary position conducting biological inspections and providing environmental education at Lake Berryessa. The Lake Berryessa Mussel Prevention Interns conduct watercraft screenings and inspections for invasive species (quagga and zebra mussels) and provide invasive species education to Lake Berryessa users. This position will not exceed 40 hours/week or 1000 hours in a year. Required hours are primarily Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from approximately 6:00AM to 2:00PM and/or 10:00AM to 6:00PM as well as additionally scheduled weekday shifts, meetings, and trainings.

Employment Duration: April 1, 2019 - October 14, 2019

Internship duration may be flexible depending on student availability.

Internship duration may be extended for some individuals dependent on Water Agency needs.

Essential Job Functions:

- Approximately 85% Field, 15% Office
- After achieving Level I Watercraft Inspection Training, conduct boat screenings and inspections for invasive aquatic species.
- Educate boaters on invasive aquatic species and how to prevent the spread of invasive species.
- Organize and maintain an inventory of program materials and supplies.
- Organize and manage data and photos collected each week.
- Prepare weekly and final summaries of the data collected.
- Help analyze and create a final report on all program data collected; present summary in a formal setting.
- Other duties as assigned.

Benefits for Lake Berryessa Mussel Inspection Interns:

- Resume and cover letter workshop.
- Enhanced presentations skills (interns present final data to partner agencies).
- Professional growth in teamwork, leadership, data management, and public relations.
- Certification through recognized government agencies.

Additional Requirements: Interns must complete the Level I Watercraft Inspection Training and certification within 30 days of employment. The course will be offered through the Solano County Water Agency.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current student in the process of an undergraduate degree or a recently graduated student within the last six months. Preferred but not required.
- Focus of study or declared major in: environmental science, environmental planning, engineering, watershed science, biology, ecology, soil and water science, public relations or similar field. Preferred but not required.
- Prior experience in customer service preferred but not required.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills as well as the ability to multi-task.
- Must be comfortable working alone, with a partner, and on a team.
- Must be able to work in extreme heat and inclement weather.
- Environmental education and outreach experience encouraged but not required.
- Reliable transportation and a valid CA Driver's license.
- Good driving record as evidenced by freedom from multiple or serious traffic violations or accidents for at least two (2) years duration. Driving record must not contribute to an increase in the Agency's automobile insurance rates.

- Willingness to have a relatively consistent schedule (minimum of 12 hours per week, maximum of 40 hours per week) and perform other tasks as assigned by SCWA staff.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Must possess mobility to work in the field and in a standard office setting and use standard office equipment, including a computer; strength, stamina, and mobility to perform medium physical work; vision to read printed materials and a computer screen; and hearing and speech to communicate in person and over the telephone or radio. Finger dexterity is needed to access, enter and retrieve data using a computer keyboard or tablet. Internships listed above bend, stoop, kneel, reach and climb to perform work and perform inspections. Interns must possess the ability to lift, carry, push, and pull materials and objects necessary to perform job functions.

ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS

Interns partially work in an office environment with moderate noise levels, controlled temperature conditions and no direct exposure to potentially hazardous physical substances. Interns also work in the field and are exposed to loud noise levels, cold and hot temperatures, inclement weather conditions, road hazards, chemicals, mechanical and/or electrical hazards, and hazardous physical substances and fumes. Interns may interact with upset members of the public.

COMPENSATION:

Internships are temporary positions (\$16 per hour). Medical, dental, vision, and retirement benefits are not provided. Sick leave is accrued at 1 hour for every 30 hours worked. Candidates will be required to drive to their primary reporting locations, and mileage will be provided for work-related driving.
