Water Conservation

The State Water Resources Control Board's adoption of revised emergency water conservation regulations, which under specific circumstances allow for the relaxation of mandatory conservation requirements, has evoked considerable criticism by some organizations and individuals, who are concerned that relaxation of the mandatory conservation requirements sends the wrong message to the public. In a similar vein, a statewide poll conducted by the Public Policy Institute of California in July, 2016, found that 63 percent of likely voters believe State and local governments are not doing enough to respond to the current drought. Long story short, it is imperative that we not only continue, but expand our water conservation outreach efforts.

Statewide Mercury Control Program for Reservoirs

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) is developing a statewide mercury control program for reservoirs. The primary goal of the program is to reduce methylmercury concentrations in fish and ultimately, to protect human health. Due to the relatively high, naturally occurring concentrations of mercury in the soils and geologic material of northern California, including the Putah creek drainage, keeping mercury out of reservoirs such as Lake Berryessa presents significant challenges. The proposed program, as currently scoped, includes development of a TMDL (Total Maximum Daily Load) regulatory standard for mercury-impaired reservoirs and also requires owners and operators of "mercury-impaired reservoirs", one of which is Lake Berryessa, to conduct pilot mercury remediation tests that would provide the basis for developing long-term reservoir mercury management plans. While the goals of the proposed program are laudable, given the naturally occurring concentrations of mercury, staff is concerned that there are few practical remedies available to Lake Berryessa and that implementation of any TMDL and associated actions will be at best, modestly effective, but very expensive.



Delta Smelt Resiliency Strategy

Delta Smelt issues have dominated the headlines of late and may be one of the few issues that is receiving more press coverage than the Kardashians. Last month the State released the "Delta Smelt Resiliency Strategy", which outlines a series of proposed actions – habitat restoration, flow augmentation and reoperation of water conveyance facilities – intended to increase Delta Smelt populations. Historically, Delta Smelt populations where widely distributed throughout the Delta. However, Delta Smelt populations are now largely limited to the northern Delta, most notably, from the Cache Slough Complex to Montezuma Slough in the Suisun Marsh. Recently, Delta Smelt have also been observed in the Yolo Bypass Toe Drain and the Sacramento Ship Channel.

Increasingly, the fate of Delta Smelt and the management of Solano County's water resources are becoming intertwined. Since the early 1990's Delta Smelt pumping restrictions have been periodically imposed on the North Bay Aqueduct – one of, if not the primary motivation for development of the North Bay Aqueduct Alternate Intake Project. However, habitat restoration efforts outlined in the Delta Smelt Resiliency Strategy, most notably stormwater management and flow augmentation in the Yolo Bypass to move food rich water toward the Cache Slough Complex and beyond, are now coming into play and could eventually impact Solano Project operations and Lower Putah Creek, which drains into the Yolo Bypass; the Ulatis Flood Control Project, which drains into Cache Slough; and the Petersen Ranch property, located at the confluence of Barker and Lindsey sloughs.

During the 1990's, considerable staff time was directed toward the Solano Project, Putah Creek, and the Lake Berryessa watershed. Today and for the foreseeable future I anticipate the focus will be on the Yolo Bypass, Delta Smelt, and the North Bay Aqueduct.

Petersen Ranch

On July 8, 2016 escrow closed and the Water Agency took ownership of the 1,600 acre Petersen Ranch. The property, particularly the lower 350 acres adjacent to Lindsey Slough are ideally suited for tidal wetlands restoration that could ultimately play a role in sustaining Delta Smelt populations in the Cache Slough Complex. However, as became evident during escrow, the property is also ideally suited and will largely satisfy the Water Agency's habitat restoration/enhancement obligations pursuant to the soon to be adopted Habitat Conservation Plan.

Staff is working with a contractor to remove garbage and other debris from the property, and later this month will begin a study to more fully evaluate the potential habitat restoration options and more specifically, opportunities to maximize habitat restoration credits.

SGMA Update - Solano Sub Basin

Staff members of the various GSA eligible agencies, landowners, and other interested stakeholders have been meeting over the last several months to develop one or more proposed GSA governance structures for the Solano Subbasin. The most recent meeting occurred on August 4, 2016. The group is scheduled to meet in late August, at which time it is anticipated one or more proposed draft GSA governance structures will finalized and ready for review and

comment by elected officials. The draft GSA governance(s) structure is tentatively scheduled to be presented and discussed at the October SCWA Board meeting.

Strategic Planning Update

On August 1, 2016 the Strategic Planning Stakeholder Group met to review the draft Strategic Plan. Final edits are being made and the revised draft will be ready for Board review at the September Board meeting. At the September Board meeting staff will present and provide an overview of the draft strategic plan for the purposes of receiving initial Board comment. The Strategic Planning Stakeholder Group anticipates the Board will want to carefully review the work tasks and priorities identified in the draft Strategic Plan – which will take time – and accordingly, is recommending the Board hold a workshop sometime after the September 8, 2016 Board meeting but before the regularly scheduled Board meeting in October, to allow sufficient time to discuss and comment on the draft strategic plan, with the expectation that the final document would be approved by the Board in October.

SCWA Hires and Retirements

I am pleased to report that Sabrina Colias and Katherine (Kat) Ashley have joined the Water Agency – both are welcome additions to the staff. Sabrina, a former Water Agency intern, has been hired to fill the new Assistant Water Resources Specialist position, while Katherine has been hired to fill the Administrative Assistant position formerly held by Sandra Willingmyre. Sandra recently obtained her Masters Degree in Accounting and is now an Accountant with the Water Agency.

Katherine Philips, the Water Agency's Administrative Services Manager, retired on July 13, 2016. Katherine served as the Water Agency's Administrative Services Manager for approximately six years. During this time she was instrumental in developing the procedures and spreadsheets currently used to formulate and track the Water Agency's annual budget. We jealously wish her well as she travels the country in her new RV.

Finally, I will be on vacation from August 11 through August 24. In my absence, Thomas Pate and Chris Lee will staff the August 11 Board meeting. I will be available by phone and e-mail should something urgent come up.

- 5) In January of each year the Board adopts an annual meeting schedule for the Legislative Committee that calls for at least one scheduled meeting every four months (quarterly meetings). The committee may elect to cancel one or more quarterly meetings, or to meet more frequently. However, for planning purposes, unless cancelled or otherwise rescheduled, quarterly meeting will occur on the date and time specified in the Board adopted meeting calendar (see attached spreadsheet for recommended "baseline" meeting schedule).

Water Policy Committee

- Each January the newly elected SCWA Board Chair appoints the Water Policy Committee members for the calendar year.
- 2 The Water Policy Committee consists of a Chair, Vice Chair, and at least one city mayor, one County Supervisor, and one irrigation district representative.
- 3 A SCWA staff member and one representative from the SCWA Advisory Commission are assigned to assist and advise Water Policy Committee members, and to provide the administrative services needed to conduct meetings.
- 4 In January of each year the Board adopts an annual meeting schedule for the Water Policy Committee that calls for at least one scheduled meeting every four months (quarterly meetings). The committee may elect to cancel one or more quarterly meetings, or to meet more frequently.
